


Faculty Quick Start: Webex Meetings: Hosting a Meeting

o1 Starting a Meeting


- 1. When a host starts or a participant joins a meeting, first step is to set audio and video options.
- 2. Once done select "Start Meeting" or "Join Meeting"

Basic Functions



- 1. Participant List:
 - As individuals join the meeting their names will appear in the participants list.
 - Right click on a participant name for options, i.e. change their role, mute them or expel them from the meeting.
- 2. Chat Panel:
 - Host and participants can text chat with all or individual participants.
 - Participant chat options can be revised by going to the top tab "Participant" > "Assign Privileges".

- 3. Microphone and Camera Controls:
 - Mute/unmute and turn on/off your webcam.
 - Use the drop-down arrow at each setting to change your options.
- 4. Share Options:
 - Host or presenter can share with participants their screen, applications, whiteboard, and browsers.

- 5. Record:
 - The session can be recorded, it is recommended to record to the cloud.

- 6. Closed Captioning (using Webex Assistant):
 - For faculty and staff to request the addition of the Webex Assistant email webex@tri-c.edu
 - Once enabled, selecting the Webex Assistant adds live captioning, as well as a transcript that can be highlighted during the session.

- 7. Breakout Sessions:
 - If not already enabled, select the top tab "Breakout Sessions" > "Enable Breakout Sessions", the Breakout Session button will then appear on the bottom dock.
