High School Articulation Agreement Between Cleveland Municipal School District and Cuyahoga Community College

Leading to an Associates Degree at Cuyahoga Community College:

For the purposes of this agreement, a Law Enforcement with Concentration in Security Administration student is defined as a student who is enrolled in and successfully completed the high school component of the approved Law Enforcement with Concentration in Security Administration program.

TO RECEIVE CREDIT THE STUDENT MUST:

- 1. The student and high school teacher must sign this form and include a completed Cuyahoga Community College application and appropriate OPOTC certificate. All three forms must be submitted to the office of Admissions and Records by June 1.
2. Successfully complete the approved high school Law Enforcement with concentration in Security Administration program and maintain a minimum of a 2.0 G.P.A. on a 4.0 scale in all coursework specified as part of the Law Enforcement with Concentration in Security Administration Program.
3. Successfully complete and receive a passing score on the State of Ohio Private Security Examination.
4. Send an official final high school transcript to Cuyahoga Community College.
5. Materials received no later than 1 year from posted graduation date.
6. Materials must indicate that the student has successfully completed the Law Enforcement with Concentration in Security Administration program.
7. The student meets the criteria as outlined for each course.

NO CREDIT WILL BE AWARDED UNTIL THE STUDENT MEETS ALL OF THE ABOVE CONDITIONS.
