#Depending on the student's fluency in Spanish, it may be possible to follow this alternative sequence: SPAN 1021, 2010, 2020, 2411, or 2010, 2020, 2411, 2420, and 2430. If this is taken, work closely with both the Tri-C Spanish faculty and CSU Spanish faculty as the degree map may change.

^{*}Students in any of our Study Abroad Programs can substitute any of the core requirements from the following list and with the approval of the instructor: SPN 340 Field Study, SPN 341 Spanish Field Study, SPN 392 Special Topics: Study Abroad.

^{**}Independent Study in Spanish (1 crd) can take the form of service learning, tutoring, internship, film festival or project. NOTE: To fulfill this requirement we can also accept SPN 396 Independent Study and SPN 397 Spanish Medical Terminology.

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***Capstone (1 crd) taken in combination with a 3 credit 400-level course. Note: Students on one of our Study Abroad Programs can take SPN 495 (Spanish Field Study Capstone) for a total of 4 credits. This will cover for the regular capstone plus one of the 400-level electives.

This Transfer Pathway completes the Associate of Arts degree, which must total at least 60 semester credits and includes 36 credits of the Ohio Transfer 36 (OT36, formerly OTM), which are approved Tri-C general education requirements. Additional Information:

Assumptions: College-level readiness in MATH and ENG.

CSU requires a minimum of 120 total credit hours for graduation. At least 30 credits must be completed in-residence at CSU. At least 24 of the in-residence credits must be completed at the upper division (300/400) level. An overall total of 42 upper division (300/400) level credits are required. Students deficient in total credits or in-residence credits must take additional elective credits to meet the minimum requirements. Depending upon other elective choices made, students may not need as many general electives as indicated above, or may need additional electives.

Students who do not complete the Associate of Arts degree will need to complete additional General Education requirements at Cleveland State University.
