Assumptions: college-level readiness in MATH and ENG; no Foreign Language Deficiency (FLD). NOTE-this is different from the Foreign Language Requirement (FLR) which is a requirement in the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences at John Carroll University (JCU).

John Carroll University requires a minimum of 120 total credit hours for graduation. At least 60 credits must be completed inresidence at John Carroll University. All general requirements, Core requirements, and all requirements for the major must be completed along with a quality-point average of at least a 2.0 for graduation. Students deficient in total credits or in-residence credits or in quality-point average requirements must take additional elective credits to meet the minimum requirements. Depending upon other elective choices made, students may not need as many general electives as indicated above, or may need additional electives.

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This map represents one example of how to complete the Associate and Bachelor's degrees. Students should work closely with advisors at both institutions to discuss options.
