
Please Join Us! Veterans recognition ceremony

The area's largest Veterans Day Ceremony will be held on Veterans Day, Friday, Nov. 11 at 11:00 a.m. in the Rotunda at Cleveland City Hall. This year's event will honor **Tri-C's 2016 Student Veteran of The Year**, Clayton Angeloff, a Strongsville native who is an Emergency Medical Technology student at Western Campus. A former combat medic in Iraq, Angeloff is credited with saving the life of a fellow Tri-C student in August. He enlisted in the United States Air Force to become a firefighter, and was assigned to the 20th Civil Engineering Squadron at Shaw Air Force Base in South Carolina after Basic Training. After an overseas deployment, Angeloff chose to return home pursue an Emergency Medical Technology degree through Tri-C. He plans to become a medic after graduation.
