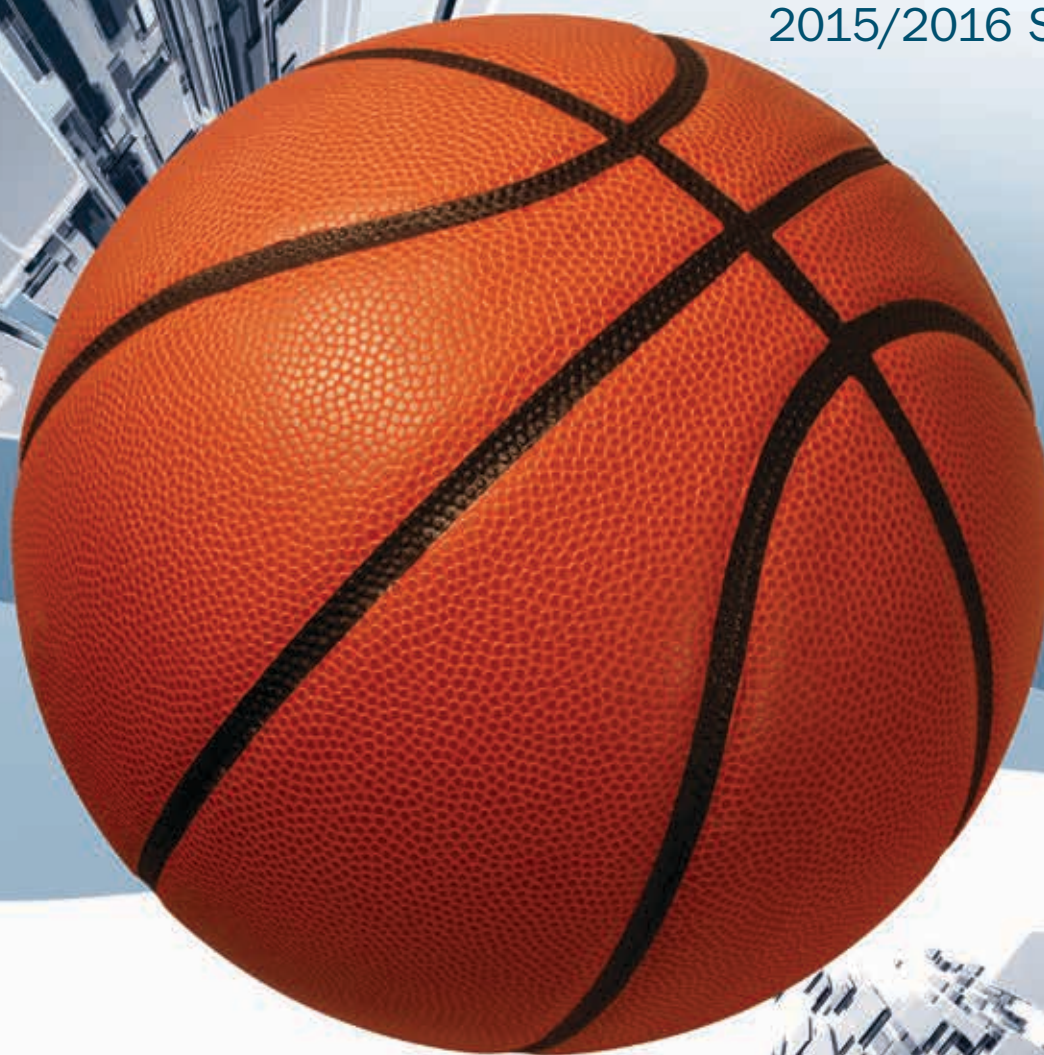

Cuyahoga Community College is a member of the National Junior College Athletic Association and participates in the Ohio Community College Athletic Conference with other two-year colleges.



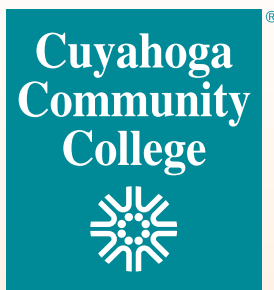
PARTICIPATION AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE
