I. Graduation rates and RHIT Examination rates:

The Health Information Management Technology degree program graduated 14 students in 2020.

- Seven part time students started the HIMT program in fall semester 2017
 - o Five graduated in 2020
 - o 71.4% graduation rate
- 10 fulltime students started the HIMT program in fall semester 2018
 - o 9 graduated in 2020
 - o 91% graduation rate

II. Registered Health Information Technology (RHIT) credentialing examination results 2020 graduates

As of December 31, 2020, four of the above graduates took the RHIT examination:

- Four Students passed the RHIT examination on the first attempt
- 100% pass rate for the 2020 HIMT graduates who took the examination.
- Ten students have yet to take the exam

III. Admissions and retention rates fall of 2020

In the fall semester of 2020 the HIMT degree program accepted:

- Four day students (full time) and
- Five evening students (part time)

As of February 1, 2021

 All nine students progressed to the spring 2021 semester program for a retention rate of 100%

Second and Third Year students:

o Fall 2020 to spring 2021 showed a 100% progression/retention rate

Satisfaction rates 2018

100% of employers surveyed who have hired graduates from 2017 to the present are either Extremely Satisfied or Very Satisfied with the graduates and their training and abilities to perform duties as described.
