Associate of Applied Science Degree in Health Information Management Technology

Graduation rates and RHIT Examination rates:

The Health Information Management Technology degree program graduated 24 students in 2016.

- Nine *part Time* students started the HIMT program in fall semester 2012 and 2013
 - Eight graduated in 2016
 - 89% graduation rate
- Fifteen *fulltime* students started the HIMT program in fall semester 2014
 - Fifteen graduated in 2016
 - 100% graduation rate

Registered Health Information Technology (RHIT) credentialing examination results 2016

As of December 31, 2016, fifteen graduates took the RHIT examination:

- Thirteen Students took and passed the RHIT examination on the first attempt
- Two students passed the exam on their second attempt
- 100% pass rate for the 2016 HIMT graduates who took the examination.
- Nine students have yet to take the exam

Admissions and retention rates fall of 2016

In the fall semester of 2016 the HIMT degree program accepted

- 18 day students (full time) and
- 14 evening students (part time)

As of February 1, 2016

- all 32 students are progressing in the program for a retention rate of 100%

Satisfaction rates 2016

100% of employers surveyed who have hired graduates from 2016 are either Extremely Satisfied or Very Satisfied with the graduates and their training and abilities to perform duties as described.

93% of graduates surveyed reported that students are Extremely Satisfied or Very Satisfied with their education and felt they were prepared by the program at Cuyahoga Community College to perform the duties and job functions in the healthcare field as described.
