TRI-C/CWRU STEM ARTICULATION PROJECT

Dual enrollment is available to undergraduate students in good academic standing. The student may take two undergraduate courses (plus accompanying lab with fees to be paid by the student, if required) each term. The student must be interested in a STEM related degree, qualify for MATH 1240 or higher, completed English 1010 and maintain a C average. Admission is granted on a space availability basis. Not all courses are open to dual enrollment. A student may cross register in only one institution each term. Prior approval of credit transfer is the student's responsibility. The host institution will send an official transcript to the home institution at the completion of the term. CWRU has requested registrations for Fall semester be submitted by the end of the 1st week of August and for Spring Semester by the end of the 2nd week of December.
