



**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT  
CUYAHOGA COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT  
AND OHIO DOMINICAN UNIVERSITY**

Cuyahoga Community College District, hereafter CCC, and Ohio Dominican University, hereafter ODU, enter into this agreement in order to enhance mutual cooperation and to better facilitate the transfer of students between institutions.

This agreement seeks to clarify the status and treatment of students who choose to transfer from the CCC Associate of Applied Science Law Enforcement degree to the Bachelor of Arts program in Criminal Justice at ODU.

For the purposes of this agreement, potential transfer students will be categorized as follows:

1. CCC students who transfer to ODU before completing an Associate of Applied Science degree in Law Enforcement (any option).
2. CCC students who transfer to ODU upon completion of the Associate of Applied Science degree.

In all cases, a minimum of 124 semester hours will be required for completion of a baccalaureate degree. The determination of the requirements for all baccalaureate degree programs will be the responsibility of the ODU. Cuyahoga Community College students who transfer and have completed the Associate of Applied Science Degree – Law Enforcement will be granted catalog rights at Ohio Dominican based on their initial enrollment to this articulation program and will be subject to the same terms as ODU native students. Students transferring prior to completing the degree will be subject to curriculum and policies in effect at the date of transfer. In addition, remedial coursework in basic skills will not count toward the graduation requirements for baccalaureate programs at ODU.

**Students who transfer prior to completion of Associate of Applied Science Degree**

CCC students who desire to transfer to ODU or any of its regional campuses before completing an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree program will be admitted according to ODU admission standards and policies. All credits earned with a grade of C or better may be transferred to ODU; however, the applicability of this credit to the requirements for baccalaureate programs at ODU will be determined on a course-by-course basis.

### **Students who transfer upon completion of the Associate Degree**

Subject to the terms of this agreement, students who have earned an Associate of Applied Science degree – Law Enforcement at CCC will be admitted to ODU or any of its regional campuses. They will be granted junior level standing if a minimum of 56 semester hours have been completed with a grade of C or better for each course taken within the 56 semester hours. In addition, the following general principles will apply to CCC students who transfer to ODU upon the completion of an Associate of Applied Science degree program in Law Enforcement:

1. For admission to ODU, the student will be required to earn at least a 2.0 overall grade point average on a 4-point scale.
2. Students who have completed an Associate of Applied Science Degree – Law Enforcement will be granted unconditional admission to ODU in the Criminal Justice – E Learning Program Option.
3. All credits earned with a grade of C or better will be transferred to ODU as outlined in the attached Transfer Guides. Additional courses will be reviewed on a course by course basis.

### **Cuyahoga Community College and ODU will:**

1. CCC will assign an Admissions Officer and/or advisor to ensure that CCC students in this program receive information about baccalaureate program requirements, including the admission criteria for ODU programs that have limited enrollments and/or selective admission criteria.
2. CCC students admitted to ODU under this program (and who have attended CCC at least one semester) may attend ODU or any of its regional campuses as transient students without paying an additional matriculation fee. Prior to such attendance, the student should file an application form for transient work with the appropriate CCC dean.
3. CCC students admitted to ODU under this program (and who have attended ODU at least one semester) may attend CCC as transient students without paying an additional matriculation fee. Prior to such attendance, the student should file an application form for transient work with the appropriate ODU academic dean.
4. CCC students transferring to ODU under this program will have an equal opportunity to pre-register for junior level classes, provided all prerequisites have been met, and will have equal access to other student services as similarly-qualified students attending ODU.
5. Subject to all deadlines applicable to ODU students, CCC students admitted to this program will have an equal opportunity to apply for financial aid and will receive equal consideration in the award and distribution of funds.
6. Upon request and with each student's approval, ODU will provide to CCC specific follow-up information for each student for the duration of the student's undergraduate/graduate tenure at the ODU.

Upon approval of this agreement, ODU will work with CCC to develop articulated transfer guides for selected baccalaureate programs to facilitate the transfer of students and provide them with early information about program requirements. Transfer guides will be reviewed and published annually. CCC and ODU will each assign a staff member to serve as a liaison and to assure continued communication between the two institutions on matters related to this agreement. In addition, ODU will prepare an annual analysis of the program of CCC students transferring to ODU to be used in advising prospective transfers and to evaluate the success of CCC transfers.

This agreement will remain in effect until modified by mutual agreement or terminated by CCC or ODU. A one-year notice is required prior to termination.

CCC and ODU authorize this agreement to become effective on June 15, 2004.
