Fire to EMS Instructor

Eight-hour course that bridges Fire Instructor to an EMS Instructor.

COURSES

CCEMT-P

The course is designed to prepare paramedics and nurses to function as members of a critical care transport team. Participants will gain an understanding of the special needs of critical patients during transport, become familiar with the purpose and mechanisms of hospital procedures and equipment and develop the skills to maintain the stability of hospital equipment and procedures during transport.

Heartsaver/AED

Heartsaver AED course teaches the basic techniques of adult CPR and the use of the AED (automatic external defibrillator).

Practical Skills Testing for EMS Instructor

This course is designed to prepare participants to become an EMS Instructor. The course meets #4 of the EMS Instructor Training Program entrance requirements.

30-Hour EMT - Basic Refresher Course

This course meets the requirements of the Ohio Department of Public Safety (ODPS) 30 hour EMT Basic Course, 4765-15-01.

EMS Instructor

This course is an EMS instructor training program which shall consist of seventy hours. This course is designed for individuals seeking certification as an EMS instructor, who hold at least a baccalaureate degree in education.

48-Hour EMT - Paramedic Refresher Course

This course will provide the learner with information needed to recognize infants and children at risk for cardiopulmonary arrest. Basic Life Support (BLS) for Healthcare Provider/CPR.

EMS Continuing Education

EMS Continuing Education can be designed to meet your individual or organization's needs.

Basic Life Support (BLS) for Healthcare Provider/CPR

This course is designed to teach the skills of CPR for victims of all ages (including barrier device, bag mask device, and oxygen, use of an automated external defibrillator (AED) and relief of foreign body airway obstruction (FBAO)). It is intended for individuals who provide healthcare to patients in a wide variety of settings.
