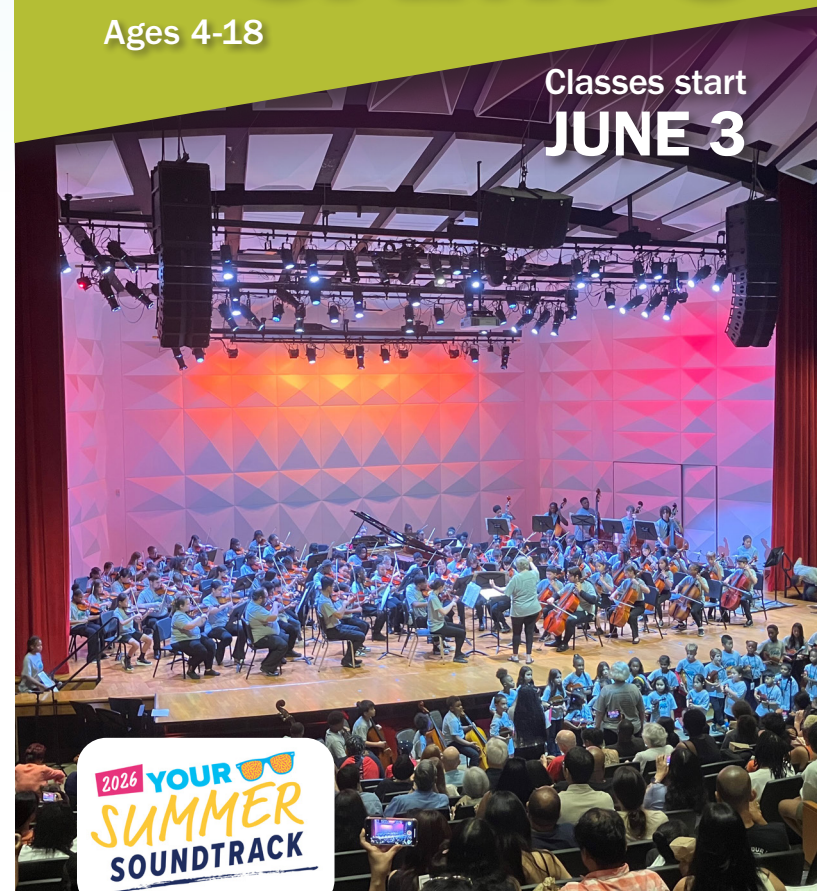

Tri-C Summer Concert Band Camp

Ages 10-18 | Cost: Free (Lunch provided)

Strings Attached Summer Camp

Ages 6-18 | Cost: Free (Lunch provided)

Orchestra string players (violin, viola, cello and double bass) will polish their instrumental skills through a mastery-based approach that includes sectional and ensemble rehearsals, music theory, and sight-reading. Students are evaluated and placed in levels appropriate to their experience. All students participate in a string orchestra performance at the end of the camp session.

Session A

Three-week camp for intermediate and advanced level students entering 5th through 12th grade.

Session A string ensemble classes include orchestral and chamber repertoire, and will feature special guest artists in a workshop/performance setting. Classes will also combine with a language arts class in which students learn journaling, storytelling and poetry, collaborating with classmates to create a performance with original words and music.
