A MOMENT IN HISTORY: THE 80TH ANNIVERSARY OF D-DAY

On June 6, 1944, the world witnessed a pivotal moment in history with the Allied invasion of Normandy, famously known as D-Day. This meticulously planned operation saw thousands of troops from the United States, Great Britain, Canada and other Allied nations storming the beaches of Normandy, France, in a daring assault against the Nazi-occupied beachhead. Under the command of General Dwight D. Eisenhower, Operation Overlord began with airborne and amphibious landings along a 50-mile stretch of the Normandy coast. Despite facing formidable German defenses, the Allied soldiers displayed unparalleled courage and determination. The beaches of Omaha, Utah, Juno, Gold and Sword became the battlegrounds where countless acts of heroism unfolded amidst the chaos of war. D-Day marked a turning point in the Second World War, signaling the beginning of the end of Nazi Germany's grip on Europe. The successful invasion opened a vital Western Front, paving the way for the

liberation of occupied territories and the ultimate defeat of the Axis powers. D-Day remains a symbol of Allied unity, sacrifice and triumph in the face of adversity, forever etched into the annals of history as one of the most significant military operations of the 20th century.
