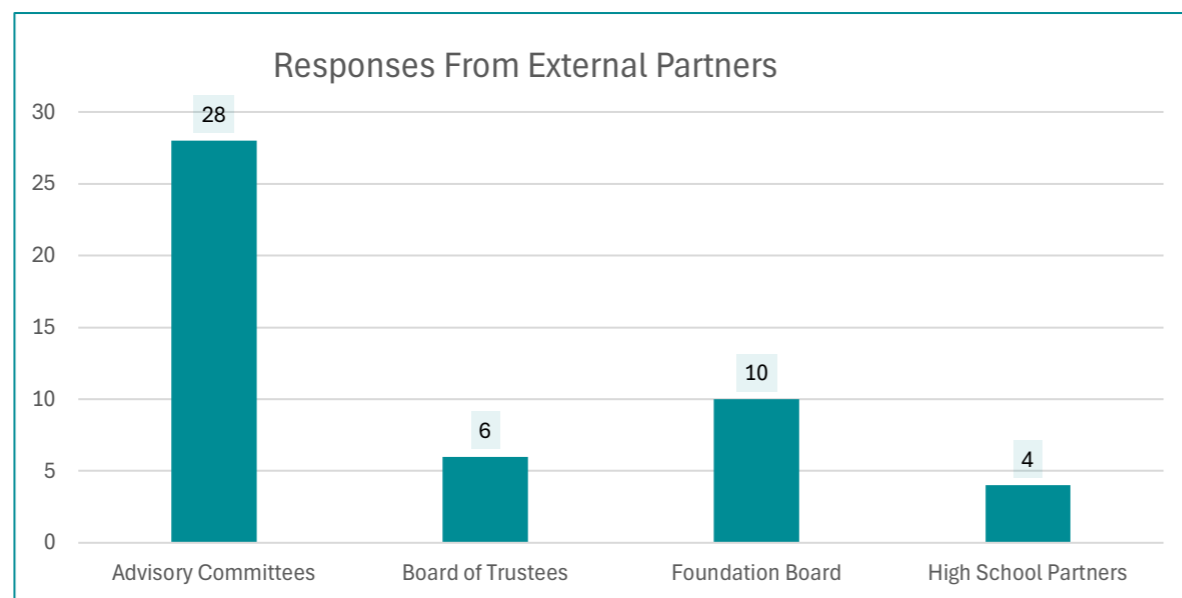
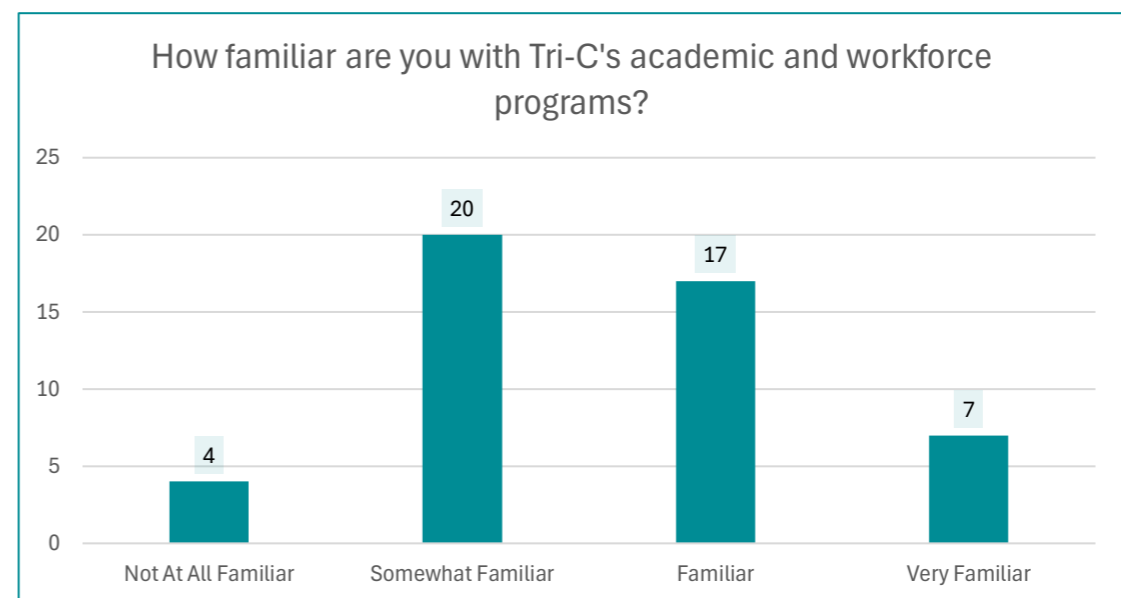


Academic Plan External Partner Survey Results

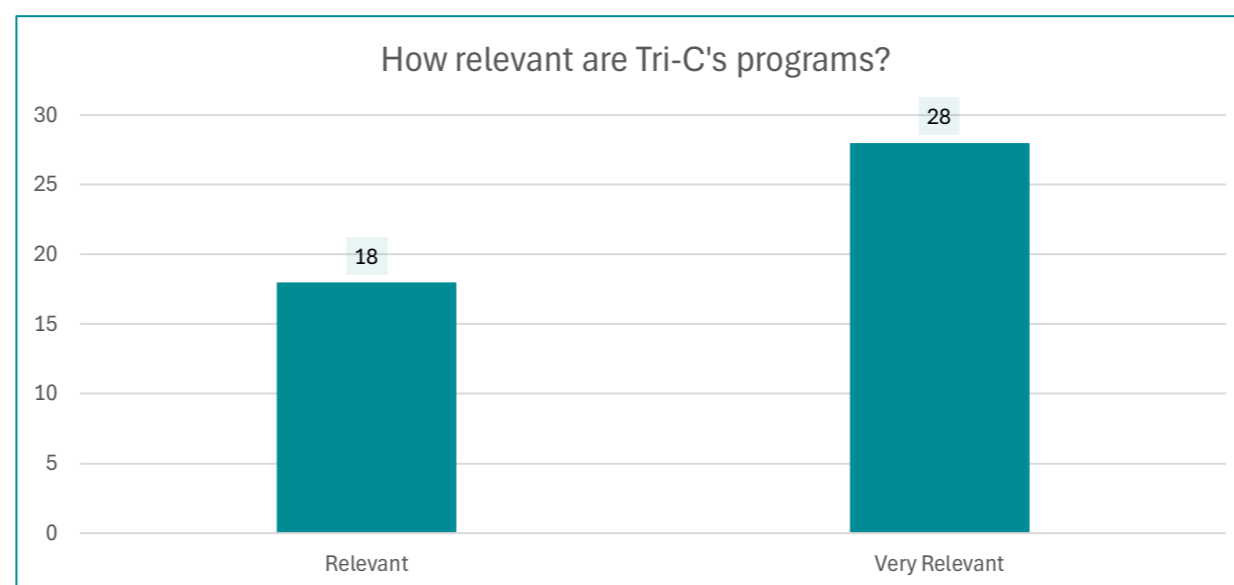
48 Total Responses

Prevalent themes included that Tri-C continue to prepare students for the local workforce or transfer to a four-year institution, that the College supports the regional economy and also furthers career development. Results showed that some programs may be better aligned to the area workforce than others. Recommendations included more transfer pathways, increasing visibility of programs offered, and increasing the knowledge external partners about programs offered.
