Robert C. Banks, Sr. has taught Chemistry on the Metropolitan Campus of Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C[®]) since 1967.

Mr. Banks is the co-author of numerous articles on drug research related to endocrinology (the specialty of medicine dealing with hormones). He also is engaged with community drug and alcohol treatment programs

Mr. Banks a Retired Colonel in the U.S. Army Reserves, where he served from 1953 – 1984. From 1975 – 1981, Mr. Banks was designated as the local Liaison Officer to the U.S. Military Academy, and in this capacity, Mr. Banks advised young men and women aspiring to military careers.

Mr. Banks earned an A.B. from Case Western Reserve University, an M.Ed. from Cleveland State University, and a Certification in Clinical Chemistry Technology from the American Association of Clinical Chemists.
