



## Timely Warning

**Date of Issue:** August 9, 2026

**Nature:** Reported Fondling

**Date of Incident:** August 8, 2026

**Location:** Western Campus, GCRTA Bus Stop / Theater Area

The Department of Campus Police and Security Services (CPSS) received a report that a female was groped by a male at the Western Campus. The incident was reported to have occurred in the vicinity of the Theater Arts Building and the nearby bus stop. The incident remains under investigation.

The reported suspect was described as a Black male with dreadlocks wearing all-red clothing. He was last observed boarding a Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (GCRTA) bus at approximately 2:20 p.m. His current whereabouts are unknown.

Members of the College community are encouraged to remain alert, be aware of their surroundings, and promptly report suspicious behavior. Whenever possible, travel with others, remain in well-lit areas, and use available campus safety services.

Community members are also encouraged to download and use the Tri-C Safe mobile app. The app includes Friend Walk, Safe Walk, and Mobile Blue Light features that can provide additional assistance while traveling on or near campus.
