Essay speaker applicants must:

- Be a current student at Cuyahoga Community College or Cleveland State University and in good academic standing as of Fall 2020 semester.
- Write a brief essay incorporating the following quote from Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.; "Our lives begin to end the day we become silent about things that matter."
- Submit a double-spaced, typedessay, in 200 words or less, demonstrating howyou incorporate the quote "Our lives begin to end the day we become silent about things that matter" in community and education to create positive social change in areas such as health, community safety, education, housing or job opportunities. How does your vision connect to the moral leadership and legacy of social justice and human rights of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.? What initiatives, or personal or career goals would this MLK Jr. quote inspire you to create?
- This year, Cuyahoga Community College and Cleveland State University's Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Holiday Celebration will be held virtually. Thus, if selected, essay presenters must be willing to participate in the recording of a 3- to 5- minute oral presentation of your written essay that will be aired during the 30<sup>th</sup> Annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Celebration on Tuesday, January 19, 2021, at 8:30 a.m. Cuyahoga Community College's two selected essay presenters' 3- to 5- minute oral presentations will also be aired during Cuyahoga Community College's 44<sup>th</sup> Annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Celebration on Sunday, January 17, 2021, at 2:30 p.m., which will also be held virtually.
