



## Advanced Coursework Checklist

For a 1000 level course to be classified as Advanced Coursework, it must meet Content level, Prerequisite chain, and Transferability criteria.

	Criteria	Description
<u>MUST</u>	Content Level	Advanced Coursework level course requires <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• application skills such as interpretation, demonstration of knowledge, organizational skills, problem solving and classification of information.</li><li>• critical thinking skills such as, analysis and differentiation, ability to compare and contrast, examination and assessment skills, planning, formulation, and the ability to draw conclusions.</li><li>• adaptation of knowledge, performance skills, construction and design.</li></ul>
<u>MUST</u>	Prerequisite Chain	Advanced Coursework level course requires <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• prior knowledge that is provided in at least one 1000-level prerequisite course.</li></ul> OR <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• requires that students demonstrate mastery of 1000-level general education requirements, such as 1000-level English.</li></ul>
<u>MUST</u>	Transferability	For a 1000 level course to be classified as Advanced Coursework: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Provide a copy of one or more U-Select reports from an Ohio – 4 year university to demonstrate that course transfers as 2000 level or above for the baccalaureate course.</li><li>• Transferability can be evaluated using the U-Select System <a href="https://www.transfer.org/uselect/">https://www.transfer.org/uselect/</a></li></ul>
