- CRES Procured offtake agreement on behalf of Sewer District and Tri-C
- CRES Sleeved PPA established by Sewer District and Tri-C
- Direct PPA with renewable developer

Additionally:

- June-July 2025 start date delivering into PJM ISO
- Seeking physical delivery only
- Not interested in Virtual Power Purchase Agreements (VPPAs)
- Entities are contracting separately
- Developers leveraging the incentives outlined in Inflation Reduction Act (IRA)
- Highlight success stories in public sector, higher-education, and other sectors
