# **Registration Information**

Returning Students with a Tri-C student number: Returning/existing students can register directly for your preferred program on the Creative Arts web page, or you can send an email to <a href="mailto:creativeartsacademy@tri-c.edu">creativeartsacademy@tri-c.edu</a> and request that our office register your student.

Please include their first <u>AND</u> last name, their date of birth, S#, and the program name (example--"Vocal Arts Mastery Program")

**New Students:** If your child is new to Tri-C, you must first "apply" for a Tri-C account for your student:

#### **Step 1: Create An Account**

- Click HERE
- Select Start Application, then Tri-C Application for Admission
- Create an account for each child registering for the Creative Arts Academy. Enter your child's information (child's full name, date of birth, and a unique email address NOT affiliated with another Tri-C account)
- You will also create a password. Please remember this password
- Term: Select "Non-Credit July 2025-June 2026" from the Dropdown Options
- Campus: Select "Metro Campus" from the Dropdown Options
- Select "Create An Account" which will then require you to authenticate your email address with a code sent to the email used to create the account.

# **Step 2: Start New Application**

- Enter the authentication code once you receive it, and then you will be on a new page and select "Tri-C Application for Admission" at the top.
- Select "Continue Application"

- Under "What brings you to Tri-C", select "High School or Middle School Student
   Options/Summer Camps/Youth Programs" from the Dropdown Options and then
   select "Go To Next Step"
- Under Academic Plans, select "Other Youth Programs", and then under "I Want to Take Classes as a:" select "Summer Camps or Other Youth Programming Student" from the Dropdown Options.
- Under "When do you want to start?", select "Non-Credit July 2025-June 2026" from the Dropdown Options, and under "What would you like to study:" select "Non-Credit Program – S999 \ Non-credit". Then select "Go To Next Step".
- Personal Information—enter your child's personal information including social security number which is required since Tri-C is a public institution; then select "Go To Next Step".
- Contact Information—enter your child's contact information, including your child's phone number if they have one, or use a parent phone number; then select "Go To Next Step".
- Demographic Information—enter your child's demographic information, then select "Go To Next Step".
- Academic History—Select your child's grade level; the select "Go To Next Step."
- Emergency Contact—Enter parent or guardian information; then select "Submit".
- Complete Final Crime Acknowledgements which are required by Tri-C as a public institution; enter names at the bottom, then select "Submit Your Application".

### Step 3: Wait for Application to be approved

A confirmation will be sent to the student's email address used for the application. It
will take 7-10 business days for the application to be processed. Once accepted,
you will receive another email from Tri-C Admissions confirming your acceptance to
Tri-C; and it will also include your child's S#.

## Step 4: Register for your preferred program

Once you have the S#, you can register directly for your preferred program on the
Creative Arts web page, or you can send an email to <u>creativeartsacademy@tri-</u>
<u>c.edu</u> and request that our office register your student. Please include their
first <u>AND</u> last name, their date of birth, S#, and the program name (example"Vocal Arts Mastery Program")
