# Spring Athletes of the Week Announced

**SPRINGFIELD, Ohio** – Cuyahoga Community College nearly swept the latest OCCAC's Spring Sport Athletes of the Week, bringing home three of the four accolades. Sinclair Baseball's Josh Wilson spoiled the sweep by earning Pitcher of the Week recognition. For Tri-C, Lucas DiLuca is the Position Player of the Week while softballers Lexi Rehm and Daniele Revera are the Position Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively.

## **LUCAS DILUCA**

*Cuyahoga Community College  
Baseball Position Player of the Week*

DiLuca batted .500 (7-14) with three extra-base hits (three doubles, two triples) as the Challengers posted a 4-1-1 record for the week. He drove in nine runs and scored 10 runs of his own. DiLuca was a factor in all six games, recorded at least one hit or one run in each. He exploded for seven RBI in a 17-6 win over Louisburg College on March 16. DiLuca reached base at a .667 clip after drawing seven walks and swiped two bags once on the base paths.

## **LEXI REHM**

Rehm hit .515 (17-33) with five extra-base hits (three doubles, two homeruns) in a busy week which included eight games (6-2). She totaled a dozen RBI and touched home plate 11 times personally after stealing two bases. Rehm totaled five multi-hit games and recorded at least one RBI in six of eight games.

## **JOSH WILSON**

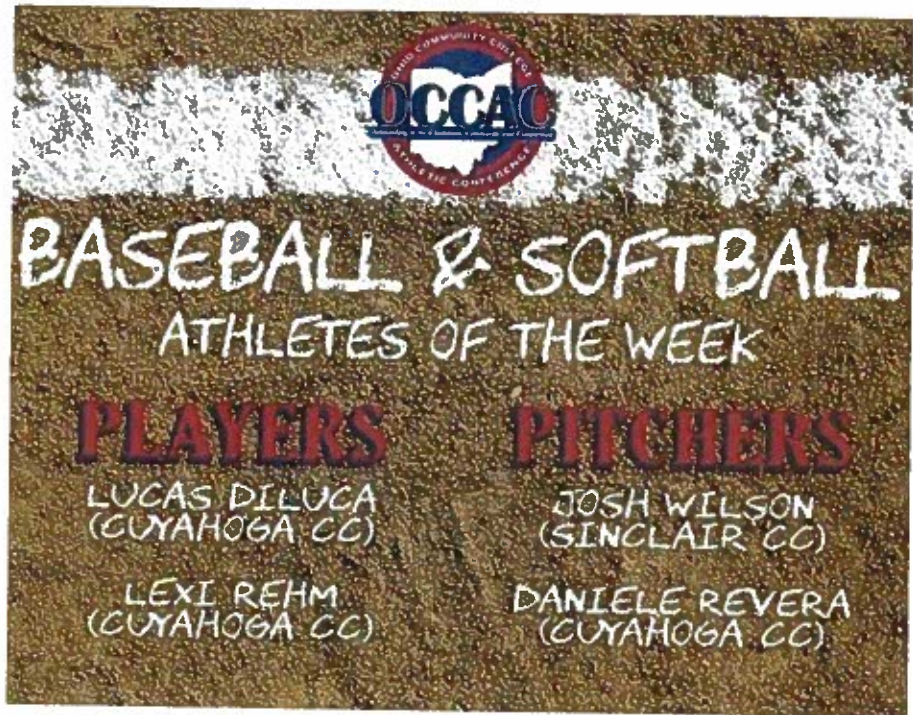

## **ALEX JACOBS**

Jacobs hit .625 (5-8) in a rain-shortened week for Sinclair. He opened with two hits in a 9-1 win over Cuyahoga before coming back in Game 2 of the doubleheader and connecting on three more base knocks, including a double. Jacobs came around to score as well in the second conference contest.

## **MARCUS JOHNSON**

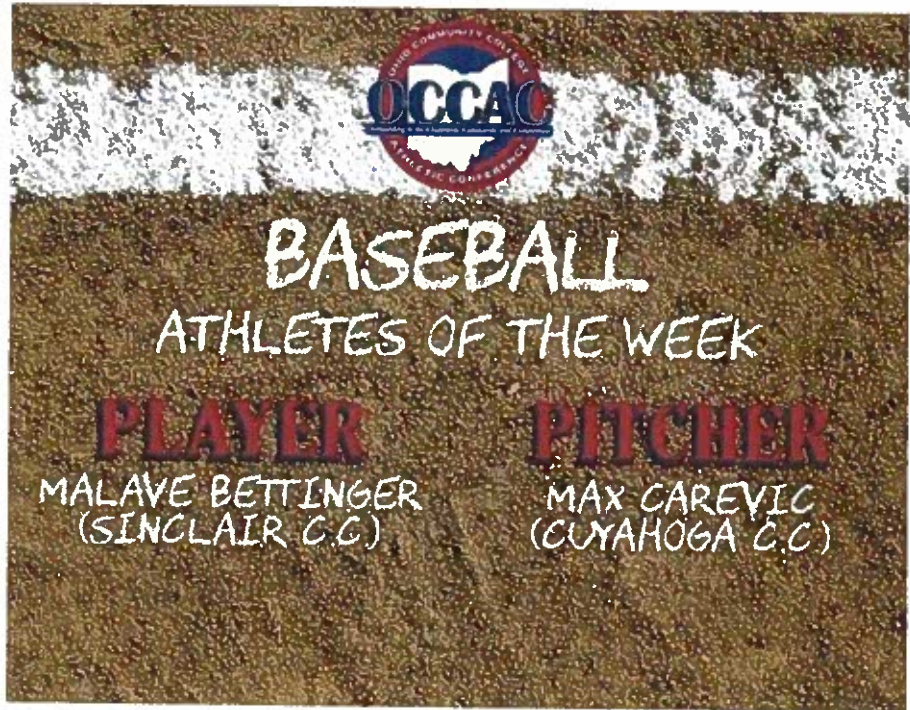

Johnson earns his second weekly honor of the season and third in his career after making two starts for Edison State last week. He toed the rubber for 13.2 innings, surrendering no earned runs and striking out 19 batters. Johnson opened the week by hurling six shutout innings in earning the win at OSU Lima on March 19 with seven Ks. While the victim of fielding errors behind him in a losing effort to Mercyhurst North East six days later, Johnson worked 6.2 more innings on the mound with zero earned runs thanks largely to a dozen strikeouts. For the week, he allowed only five walks and four hits in the 13.2 innings.

## **LUIS PADRON**

Padron played a large role in both conference victories over Clark State, delivering a minimum of two hits, a double, RBI, run scored and stolen base in both contests. He batted .625 (5-8) with three RBI and three runs for the week. Slugged two doubles and a triple to go along with two swiped bags.

## **KALLISTA HRIBAR**

Hribar picks up her second OCCAC weekly honor of the season (also selected on March 5) after racking up nine hits in four games for the Lakers. She batted .643 (9-14) with three doubles and two RBI in a 3-1 week for Lakeland. She was a terror on the base paths, stealing six bases and scoring six runs. Hribar posted multiple hits and scored at least one run in all four games while ripping a double in three contests.

## **HUDSON WIDRIG**

Widrig tossed a five-inning complete game as Lakeland run-ruled Clark State, 12-2, in the first of two OCCAC wins for the Lakers. He earned the 'W' with seven strikeouts, allowing two runs on six hits and no walks.
