- Student head of household must have primary custody of at least one child.
- Minimum 2.0 GPA is required.
- Income restrictions apply Must be under 50% Area Median Income.
- Must be a full-time student with at least one year of the program left at an accredited Ohio educational institution.
- Must complete a Housing Preference Form.
- Must be eligible for Section 8 Voucher Program.
- All applicants subject to credit and criminal background check.
