1. Placement Testing: Have you already taken your placement test?

Assessment Preparation/ Placement Testing: Log on to www.tri-c.edu/placement-testing to prepare for your placement tests. Students who have ACT, SAT, or AP scores may be exempt and should contact the Assessment Center prior to scheduling tests. If you are a non- exempt student, call 216-987-3888 (Westshore) or 216-987-5888 (Corporate College West) to schedule an appointment to take your tests. After completed, you will receive information about scheduling a New Student appointment with Counseling Services.

2. Individual New Student Counseling Appointment: At Westshore, your New Student Counseling is conducted through an individual appointment. During your initial Counseling appointment, you will learn what programs and degrees are available to you, review your first semester class options, and discuss how to balance coursework with other personal responsibilities. **Call 216-987-3900 to set up your New Student Counseling appointment.**

3. Mark your calendar to attend the combined and **mandatory New Student Orientation / New Student Convocation (course ZGEN 1003)** for the semester in which you intend to begin classes. You will register for this event during your New Student Counseling appointment.
