

Revocation of FERPA Consent Form

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) establishes certain rights for students regarding the privacy of their educational record. Students may give consent to share their educational record with authorized individuals electronically through the student portal. Students may revoke their consent by completing and submitting this "Revocation of FERPA Consent Form" to remove individuals from having access to their educational record. Forms are to be submitted in person to any Cuyahoga Community College Enrollment Center.
