“Emeritus” is an honorary appointment awarded by the Board of Trustees after official retirement to a distinguished tenured faculty member who has achieved the rank of Associate Professor or Professor, with at least 15 years of full-time service to Cuyahoga Community College. The Emeritus distinction will be reserved for those who have made extraordinary and significant contributions to Cuyahoga Community College.

To be considered for Emeritus status, a retired faculty member must be nominated by any currently employed full-time, tenured faculty member or academic administrator, during the academic year immediately following official retirement from the College and up to 24 months following the faculty member’s retirement.
