These institutions waive tuition and general fee charges for courses taken as part of the Cross-Registration program. Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C®) students are billed for the number of credits taken at the host institution using the Tri-C tuition rate once the host institution confirms registration. Tuition and fees assessed for a Cross-Registration program course will be the same as tuition and fees paid by other Tri-C students with the same number of credits and residency status. Cross registration students are required to pay for fees and electronic textbooks. These fees are not covered by the cross registration program benefits.

Cross-Registration Guidelines:

- The student is enrolled full time at one of the participating colleges or universities listed on the Tri-C Cross-Registration web page.
 - The student has obtained the proper approval from the home and host institutions.
 - The host institution determines which courses are currently available for cross-registration.
 - The student has satisfied all the course prerequisites and is in good standing at the home institution.
 - Students must register during the designated cross-registration dates of the host institution.
 - If a student drops a cross-registration course prior to completion, they must complete a drop form and submit it to the Admissions and Enrollment Services office.

Cross-registration is available to full-time students (taking at least 12 credit hours) at one of the participating institutions. The student may take one undergraduate course and must pay any accompanying fees each semester. They must also be in good standing at the home institution. Admission is granted on a space-available basis. Selected courses may not be open for cross-registration. A student may cross-register in only one institution each term. Prior approval of credit transfer is the student's responsibility.
