Export a Brightspace Course Package

Quick Summary

You can export all or part of your Brightspace course to create a backup. In Brightspace, course backups are saved as modified Common Cartridge formatted ZIP archives. This allows you to easily unzip the file on your computer to access the course files or restore the backup to another D2L Brightspace server. Additionally, some other Learning Management Systems (LMSs) may also be able to import these files. Please note that an exported course does not include student data such as grades, quiz attempts, or submission folder files.

Part 1: Package Types

Brightspace offers three types of course packages for export. For detailed information on the Common Cartridge standards, visit the <u>1EDTECH Common Cartridge webpage</u>.

- Brightspace Package: This package type is the standard export for Brightspace. It is based on the IMS Content Packaging specification. This package contains all the necessary resources you need to share your course with another Brightspace site. This package type is best suited for creating a backup of your course or sharing your course with other Brightspace users.
- Common Cartridge version 1.3: This package uses a set of open standards for content, assessment, and digital content that allows publishers and content creators to create LMSindependent course packages. It is an excellent option for OER resources. Note that features specific to Brightspace will not be exported. This package type is best suited for transferring or copying your course to a different LMS (Blackboard, Canvas, Moodle, etc.).
- Thin Common Cartridge (Thin CC) version 1.3: The Thin CC standard is a streamlined version of the Common Cartridge standard. It preserves the course organization and design, but only includes links to, and metadata about, the course content. The actual content in a Thin CC must be hosted remotely and accessed through these links. This package type is best suited for cases where your course predominantly links to external content and tools. Use it only when necessary.

Part 2: Select a Course Package Type

Step 1: Enter the course you want to export to as a package and go to "Course Admin".

Part 3: Export a Brightspace Course Package

Step 1: Complete "Part 1" and select "Export as Brightspace Package" and "Start".



Step 2: Select the components to be exported.

• To export all components, choose "Select All Components", this will add checkmarks to each item. (If you choose this option, jump to Step 4.)



• To export specific components and all its items, select the check boxes next to the desired components and then select "Export all items". (If you choose this option, jump to Step 4.)

• To export individual items and all included assets, select the check boxes next to the component.



• To export specific assets from each item, select the "+" symbol and select the desired assets.

• Repeat this process for each type of component (Modules, Discussion Boards, Quizzes, etc.).



Step 4: Confirm components to export and select "Export".

If changes are needed, select "Modify" or "Go Back". It is recommended to select the "Include course files in the export package" option to ensure include all course files are included in the course package.

Step 4: Select the components to be exported.

To export all the components, select the "Select All Components" checkbox. This will add checkmarks next to each item. To export specific components, select the checkbox next to each desired component. Then select "Continue." Please note that the Thin Common Cartridge option only allows Learning Tools Interoperability (LTI) Links, Web Links, and metadata to be exported.
