Work Study at Tri-C

The Work Study Program at Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C®) provides you with meaningful work experience through a variety of job opportunities. You can earn money by working part-time at either the College or at an approved off-site non-profit organization. Whenever possible, your work experience can be related to your educational program and career objectives.

Work Study employment is federally funded and is part of your financial aid package.
Funds are awarded on a first-come, first served basis to financial aid recipients.



Earn while you Learn

Steps to apply for the Work Study Program at Tri-C:

- 1. Complete the free application for federal student aid at www.fafsa.gov.
- 2. Confirm your award through *my Tri-C Space* or contact the Financial Aid & Scholarships Office*.
- 3. Enroll in a least six (6) credits per semester during fall and spring (You may work during summer semester even if you are not enrolled in classes).
- 4. Maintain satisfactory academic progress.
- 5. Pass an approved drug screening and background check.
- 6. Attend a mandatory new student employee orientation.
