FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the minimum requirements to be eligible for the program?

- Have a minimum of a 3.5 GPA and a 98% attendance rate
- Clean driving record and able to pass a background check (depending on local Volvo retailer requirements)
- Ability to commit to working at a Volvo retailer for a minimum of 12-months

Are there any costs associated with the Volvo TEKNIKER Technician Program?

No – there are zero costs associated with the program. All training expenses are paid for by Volvo Car USA.

Are there any post-graduation commitments?

Yes – program participants must commit to working at their Volvo retailer for a minimum of 12-months.
