Transcripts	Submit official* high school, GED, other college and/or Joint Services (for military credit) transcripts. *An official transcript must have been printed within the past year and must be sent directly from the institution in a sealed envelope marked "official." - Faxed transcripts are not accepted. - Transcripts must be received prior to being awarded financial aid and starting class. Placement Test	If you do not have eligible ACT or SAT scores or their equivalent, you must take Tri-C's placement test if you are seeking an associate degree. Tri-C students who live outside of Northeast Ohio may complete their math and English placement tests at an approved remote testing location in their local area. Register and Pay	Register for classes on the Registration tab in <i>my Tri-C space</i> . You must be prepared to pay or have financial aid requirements completed. Registration is not complete until you have paid or made arrangements to pay for your tuition and fees. www.tri-c.edu/payingforcollege	
Equipment and Books	If using financial aid, required equipment and/or books can be purchased on the Tri-C bookstore website before the start of class. Specific packages are in place for steno and voice track students which can be obtained using financial aid funds. If no financial aid, students can secure equipment from recommended sources. Signing in to my Tri-C space

Sign in to *my Tri-C space*. As soon as your application is processed, the College will generate your *my Tri-C space* account. Here, you will obtain important information regarding registration, financial aid and course planning. You can also access your student email through *my Tri-C space*. Check your email regularly for important updates.

- 1. Go to http://my.tri-c.edu
- 2. Click "Change Your Password" to create a password.
- 5. Create a new password. Re-enter the password.
- 6. Click the Change button. You will be redirected to the *my Tri-C space* login page.
- Enter your Tri-C ID (S#) and click "Continue."
 Enter your date of birth as your old password. Enter in m/d/yyyy format with no leading zeros.
- 7. Log in using your Tri-C ID and the password you just created. (You will need to create a new password every 120 days.)
