



## PNC/Live Nation Tri-C Rock Off Scholarship

Supported by PNC Bank

In Partnership with Live Nation and  
the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame

- For the 2019-2020 academic year, three scholarships of up to \$2,000 each will be awarded with a preference to graduating high school seniors who participated in the 2019 Tri-C High School Rock Off. (Students do not need to be members of the winning band.)
- To be eligible, students must enroll in Tri-C no later than **August 15, 2019**.
- Each scholarship awarded will be up to \$2,000 for the 2019-2020 academic year to be used for tuition, fees, books and academic supplies.
- Applications will be reviewed by a committee of Tri-C Center for Creative Arts faculty and staff, who will recommend up to three awards.
- Scholarship is awarded for one academic year.

Criteria for the recommended students:

1. Preference to a High School senior graduating in 2019.
2. If no applicable candidate is identified, the scholarship opportunity will be opened to prior Rock Off participants and current students pursuing their Associates degree with an emphasis in Music.
3. Students must submit an application to enroll in Tri-C.
4. Enroll in a Creative Arts major: music, theatre, dance, recording arts technology, theatre arts, visual communication and design, etc.
5. Complete the FAFSA ([www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)) and use the federal student aid code for Tri-C (003040).
6. Complete the online Tri-C scholarship application ([https://tri-c.academicworks.com/users/sign\\_in](https://tri-c.academicworks.com/users/sign_in))
7. As part of the scholarship application, submit a 250-500 word essay for the PNC/Live Nation Tri-C Rock Off Scholarship
  - a. Include the Name of the Band you were a member of for the 2019 Tri-C High School Rock Off
  - b. Essay question: What is your favorite creative work (music, dance, poetry, theater, etc.) and why? How does it reflect who you are?
8. The Office of Financial Aid will confirm that students meet the academic requirements.
