
## About Athletic Trainers

Athletic trainers (ATs) are highly qualified, multi-skilled health care professionals who render service or treatment under the direction of or in collaboration with a physician.

As a part of a health care team, athletic trainers may provide primary care, injury and illness prevention, wellness promotion and education, emergent care, examination and clinical diagnosis, therapeutic intervention, and rehabilitation of injuries or medical conditions.

## Educational Requirements

Candidates must earn a master's degree in athletic training from an accredited program and must pass a national certification exam. Most states also require licensure.


