To be considered, you must:

- Be a current Tri-C student in good academic standing (minimum 2.0 GPA as of Fall 2022);
- Submit a **typed, double-spaced essay (no more than two pages) in 12-point Times New Roman font** that demonstrates how the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. quote “The time is always right to do what is right” inspires you to create positive social change in areas such as diversity and inclusion, economics, education, employment, equity, health, housing, safety and voter engagement. Be sure to clearly convey how your vision connects with the moral leadership and legacy of social justice and human rights demonstrated by Dr. King.

- Be willing to record a 3- to 5-minute oral presentation of your written essay. Your recording will be presented during both virtual programs.
