Program Description

Student Government (SG) officers are the voice of the student body and work directly with college administration to best serve Tri-C Westshore student needs. Officers will obtain skills in public speaking, policy creation, publicity, and meeting planning and implementation.

Student Government is currently looking to fill the Treasurer & Senator positions!

The Treasurer...

- ... shall maintain permanent financial records and give a financial report at every meeting of the campus Student Government.
- ... shall maintain copies of all financial reports on all events sponsored by the campus Student Government.
- ... shall prepare and sign all payment vouchers for the campus Student Government expenses and submit payment vouchers to the campus Director of Student Engagement.
- ... shall have access to financial records of all campus student clubs and organizations.
- ... shall serve for a term of one year beginning June 1 through May 31.

The Senator-at-Large...

- ... shall represent the campus student body.
- ... shall represent the interest of the campus students while serving on campus, district or college wide committee.
- ... shall investigate proposals for new programs, or modifications to existing programs to meet the needs of the students.

Expectations

1. Maintain at least a part-time status for the entire semester and a 2.5 cumulative GPA.
2. Attend weekly SG meetings, all trainings, SG sanctioned events, and complete weekly office hours.
3. Complete all aspects of projects and initiatives you are assigned.

Important Information

1. SG officers must apply, interview, and be appointed by the Director of Student Engagement.
2. The Treasurer will be awarded a stipend equivalent to 4 in-county credit hours if expectations are met.
