



Distinguished Leadership Presentation Guide

Step One

Create a portfolio that contains, in this order:

- Section 1: General Leadership Certificate requirements
 - I. The 250-word reflection on the “Let’s Talk About It” session you attended
 - II. The 250-word reflection on Safe Zone Ally training or the descriptions and 250-word commentary on the Black American Council, Hispanic Council and SOGE Council
 - III. The Student Government or Board Student Scholar interview summary; the work you felt reflected their answers; and the 250-word reflection
 - IV. The 250-word reflection on your chosen webinar (Time Management, Motivation, How to Present the Best You Online or How to Run Productive Virtual Meetings)
 - V. The poem or song that conveys the value/lack of value of voting and 250-word reflection
 - VI. The 250-word reflection on why some believe voting is important, and why others believe it is not important
- Section 2: Advanced Leadership Certificate requirements
 - I. The 250-word reflection on your chosen movie
 - II. The 250-word reflection on your chosen podcast
 - III. The 500-word reflection on diversity and inclusion
 - IV. The 125-word reflections on each of the Student Leadership Retreat sessions or the two options you selected below:
 - a. The 500-word reflection on your Goals that Get Results experience
 - b. The 500-word reflection on Everyone Communicates, Few Connect
 - c. The 500-word reflection on How Do Our Leadership Models Fit the New Reality
 - d. The 500-word reflection on Emotional Intelligence
 - V. The option you selected below:
 - a. The chart of elected officials in your state and the corresponding essay
 - b. The visual or poem/spoken word representation of your view on voting
 - c. The summary and reflection on your local elected official interview
- Section 3: Distinguished Leadership Certificate requirements
 - I. The collection of 250-word reflections on each community service experience or the three book responses (summary, themes, impact) and event plan.

Step Two

Prepare a 20-minute presentation that incorporates the following:

- I. State what you have learned in the areas of diversity and inclusion, personal development, and civic responsibility. How will you apply what you’ve learned in the future?
- II. Establish your leadership philosophy:
 - a. What does leadership mean to you?
 - b. How is leadership impacted by diversity and inclusion? Personal development? Civic responsibility?
- III. Be prepared for 10 minutes of Q&A about your portfolio and presentation.
