Advanced Leadership Certificate Program Requirements

The Student Leadership Certificate program at Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C®) is designed to support self-exploration and discovery. Participants have the opportunity to achieve three successive, noncredit leadership certificates: General, Advanced and Distinguished.

While requirements vary, each certificate focuses on gaining experience within three categories: Diversity and Inclusion, Personal Development, and Core Responsibility.

Diversity and Inclusion

- 1. Watch one movie from the <u>Diversity and Inclusion Movie List</u>, then write a 250-word reflection.
- 2. Listen to one podcast from the <u>Diversity and Inclusion Podcast List</u>, then write a 250-word reflection.
- 3. Write a 500-word reflection that answers the following questions:
 - · What does diversity and inclusion mean to you?
 - What is an area of diversity and inclusion that challenges you? Why?
 - What is one thing you can do to learn more about the area that challenges you? How will you do that?

Personal Development

Choose one:

- 1. Attend all Student Leadership Retreat sessions, then write a 125-word reflection on each.
- 2. Complete **two** of the options below:
 - Watch <u>Goals That Get Results</u>. Create one personal goal and implement it for three weeks, keeping a daily journal. At the conclusion, write a 500-word reflection on what you learned through the experience.
 - Watch <u>Everyone Communicates</u>, <u>Few Connect</u>, then write a 500-word reflection that answers the following questions:
 - 1. How would you summarize the presentation?
 - 2. What are the key characteristics of a leader who connects?
 - 3. How do you see these characteristics manifest in your life?
 - 4. What's an area you can improve in the way you connect with others? Why?
 - 5. What is one positive way in which you connect with others? How did you develop this skill?
 - Watch <u>How Do Our Leadership Models Fit the New Reality</u>, then write a 500-word reflection that answers the following questions:
 - 1. How would you summarize the presentation?
 - 2. What are the key characteristics of effective leaders?
 - 3. How do you see these characteristics manifest in your life?
 - 4. What's an area you can improve in your leadership? Why?
 - 5. What's an area of your leadership that you are proud of? Why?



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Advanced Leadership Certificate Program Requirements (continued)

- Watch <u>Emotional Intelligence</u>, then write a 500-word reflection that answers the following questions:
 - 1. How would you describe emotional intelligence (EI) to someone?
 - 2. How can El be developed?
 - 3. What are two ways in which you can increase your EI? How would your life improve?

Civic Responsibility

Choose one:

- 1. Create a chart of elected officials in your state, then write an essay that answers the following questions (include appropriately cited sources):
 - 1. What is the purpose of each position?
 - 2. When is your next local election, and what's on the ballot?
 - 3. If someone wanted to register to vote in your city, how would they do that?
- 2. Create a visual representation of your view on voting or write a poem or spoken word piece. Your representation should address the following questions:
 - 1. Is voting important to you?
 - 2. How do your actions support or refute your belief?
 - 3. What, if anything, could you change about your behavior to best support your belief?
- 3. Interview a local elected official. Summarize their responses to the <u>Local Elected Official Interview</u> <u>Questions</u>, then write a 250-word reflection addressing what you learned and what you would like to know more about.
