## General Leadership Certificate Program Requirements

The Student Leadership Certificate program at Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C®) is designed to support self-exploration and discovery. Participants have the opportunity to achieve three successive, noncredit leadership certificates: General, Advanced and Distinguished.

While requirements vary, each certificate focuses on gaining experience within three categories: Diversity and Inclusion, Personal Development, and Core Responsibility.

### Diversity and Inclusion

- Attend [Stand For Racial Justice](#) or [Diversity](#) event and write a 250-word reflection.
- Research the [Black American Council](#), [Hispanic Council](#) and [SOGIE Council](#). Submit a description of each group, along with a 250-word commentary on why these groups are important to the Tri-C community.

### Personal Development

- Interview a member of [Student Government or the Board Student Scholar](#). Summarize their responses to the [SG/BSS Interview Questions](#), then find a song, poem or artwork you feel reflects what you heard in the interview. Submit a 250-word reflection explaining why the work you chose represents the interview. (Lyrics/prose do not count toward the 250 words.)

### Civic Responsibility

- Find a poem or song about a civic or social issue such as, but not limited to, topics on racism, voting, protest, sexism, poverty, etc. Write a 500-word essay citing two references that explains the theme of the work and demonstrates its social significance.
