

Being a Say Yes Scholar at Tri-C®

What are the requirements for the Say Yes Scholars program at Tri-C?

- Meet with your success coach twice each semester.
- Complete a Degree Works Academic Plan with a Tri-C counselor.
- Register full time in fall and spring (12 or more credits each semester).
- Complete 10 tutoring sessions or attend study tables each semester.
- Attend all mandatory Say Yes events.
- Meet with a transfer specialist.
- Communicate regularly with College Now Mentor (twice a month via Chronus; three times a year face to face).

How can I maximize my Say Yes experience?

Engage in:

- Summer experiences, including the Summer Internship Program, math enrichment, Welcome to Tri-C activities and more.
- Free student support services such as tutoring, the Writing Center and math support seminars.
- Student clubs and organizations, athletics and special campus events.
- Transfer Center college tours.

How many semesters can a student receive the Say Yes scholarship?

Students can receive the Say Yes Cleveland Scholarship for up to eight semesters and must use funds within five years of beginning their postsecondary education. Scholarships are *not* available for students to pursue master's or other postgraduate degrees. Some Tri-C students can pause the start of their Say Yes eligibility for use at a four-year college or university. See your Say Yes coach for details.

What is required to maintain the Say Yes Scholarship?

Students must:

- Enroll full time (at least 12 credit hours per semester).
- Meet satisfactory academic progress (SAP) as required by federal guidelines.
- Complete an annual Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Work with their assigned College Now mentor throughout their postsecondary education.
- Maintain eligibility for federal financial aid.

Can I receive a Tri-C Say Yes Scholarship?

Some students are eligible for a \$2,500 Say Yes Scholarship, which is different from the Say Yes Cleveland Scholarship. Students who maintain Say Yes Cleveland eligibility, engage with their Say Yes coach, register for upcoming semesters and complete the FAFSA could receive the Tri-C scholarship.
