



Being a Say Yes Scholar

For how many semesters can a student remain eligible for the scholarship?

Students can receive the Say Yes Cleveland Scholarship for up to eight semesters. They must use those eight fall or spring semesters of eligibility within five years of beginning their postsecondary education. Scholarships are NOT available for students to pursue master's or other postgraduate degrees.

What is required to maintain the scholarship?

- Students must be enrolled full time (at least 12 credit hours per semester)
- Students must meet the same Satisfactory Academic Progress as required by federal guidelines.
- Students must complete an annual Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- All scholarship students will be assigned a mentor through College Now beginning the fall after their high school graduation. Students must continue working with their assigned mentor throughout their postsecondary education.

How can I maximize the Say Yes Experience at Cuyahoga Community College?

- Students can maximize their scholarship experience by engaging in the following:
 - Regular meetings with Say Yes coach and transfer specialist.
 - Academic planning until graduation, with help from a Tri-C counselor.
 - Summer experiences including Math Bridges, Welcome to Tri-C activities and the Summer Internship Program.
 - Free student support services, such as tutoring, the Writing Center and math support seminars.
 - Student clubs and organizations, athletics and special events on campus.
