



Steps to Enroll:

- ✓ Complete New Student Orientation by visiting <https://launch.comevo.com/cuyahoga/>. You will need your Tri-C Student Number (S#) to begin. New Student Orientation is required.
- ✓ Meet with a Tri-C counselor to discuss your major, academic plan and more. All counseling appointments are currently virtual. Make an appointment here: www.tri-c.edu/counselingappointment
- ✓ Update your personal information at <http://my.tri-c.edu>.
CCP students need not reapply to attend Tri-C after high school graduation. Simply log in to *my Tri-C space* to ensure all of your personal details (including contact information and your major) are correct prior to the start of the term. Update your information on the Student tab under Academic Records → My Info.
- ✓ Apply for financial aid at www.fafsa.gov.

- ✓ Apply for Tri-C scholarships at www.tri-c.edu/scholarships.

- ✓ Make sure you have English and math placement scores on file. Submit qualifying ACT/SAT scores or prepare to take Tri-C's placement test. View testing information at www.tri-c.edu/placement-testing.
Note: If you've already passed college-level English and math, you do not need to take the placement test.
