I WILL TAKE CLASSES AT A TRI-C CAMPUS OR LOCATION

- 1. Meet with your school guidance counselor to discuss the courses you will take at Tri-C to fulfill high school graduation requirements.
- 2. Submit the online Authorization to Attend form with help from your school guidance counselor.
- Within five business days, you will receive an email to your Tri-C email confirming your form is processed and instructing you to make an appointment with a Tri-C counselor.
- 4. Meet with a Tri-C counselor to pick courses that will fulfill your degree or certificate requirements.
- 5. After your counseling appointment, you will receive an email to your Tri-C email with registration directions.
- 6. Register using the online link provided in the email.
- 7. Watch your Tri-C email for instructions on how to register for College Credit Plus New Student Orientation.
- 8. Follow the <u>CCP book order process</u> to order textbooks online.

I WILL TAKE CLASSES AT MY HIGH SCHOOL*

- Meet with your school guidance counselor to plan your schedule, including Tri-C courses you will take at your high school.
- 2. Your school will notify Tri-C of the courses you will take as part of the CCP program.
- 3. A CCP coordinator will register for you.
- 4. Textbooks will be provided by your high school.
