

What is the Advanced Technology Academy (ATA)?

ATA prepares students for job opportunities in high-demand careers through classroom instruction and hands-on, paid internships with local employers. Students are considered for full-time employment at the end of their internship. Most programs are 16 weeks or less, including job readiness skills training. Students who are eligible for the ATA program receive tuition, books, supplies and other support services at no cost.
