## **Benefits:**

- Complete Bachelor degree at Tri-C.
- Student only take two classes at a time in the Tiffin program. Classes meet only one night a week.
- Business program is offered at multiple Tri-C locations.
- Students can complete additional coursework past the Associate of Arts at Tri-C to make it more cost effective.

## **All students must complete:**

- A minimum of **(121)** semester credits (combined Tri-C and Tiffin University)
- Meet requirements **(48)** credits at a 4-year institution and 30 credit hours must be completed with Tiffin University
