## Articulation, Transfer, and Prior Learning

## Types of Articulation Agreements (which are legal documents)

- **Completion Articulation Agreements:** This is the primary bilateral legal agreement used by Tri-C. They include the future development and approval by both institutions of academic major-specific transfer pathways.
  - **Major-Specific Transfer Pathways:** Each transfer pathway is an addendum to the Completion Articulation Agreement. These transfer pathways or "maps" outline the courses students should take listed by semester, providing a clear educational plan for completing both associate and bachelor's degrees.
- **Dual Admission/Enrollment Agreements:** These agreements allow eligible students to be admitted to a four-year partner school while earning their Tri-C associate degree. Some agreements permit students to enroll in courses at both institutions simultaneously and the ability to use specified facilities and services at the four-year school.
- **Program-Specific Agreements:** These agreements pertain to specific academic programs (e.g., early enrollment for pre-med, applied degrees not covered by Completion Articulation Agreements) or for students in Tri-C Honors or the Mandel Scholars Program.
- **Ohio Guaranteed Transfer Pathways:** These are Ohio Department of Higher Education standardized transfer pathways between Ohio community colleges and public four-year universities, mandated by state law. They resemble the major-specific transfer pathways.
