Graduation Requirements

Requirements to graduate with the BA degree program: To graduate, students must have minimum 121 credit hours, 39 upper-division credits hours of coursework, a minimum 2.250 major GPA and minimum 2.000 cumulative GPA. They must also fulfill an approved experiential learning experience, a two-course diversity requirement (domestic and global), complete a writing intensive course with a minimum C (2.000) grade.

Requirements to graduate with the minor: To graduate, students must have minimum 18 credit hours, a minimum 2.250 minor GPA and minimum 2.000 cumulative GPA. Minimum 6 credit hours in the minor must be upper-division coursework (30000 and 40000 level). Minimum 6 credit hours in the minor must be outside of the course requirements for any major or other minor the student is pursuing. Minimum 50 percent of the total credit hours for the minor must be taken at Kent State (in residence).

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It is recommended that students intending to pursue the Bachelor of Arts, Architectural Studies with Ceramics minor through Kent State University consult with academic advisors at both Cuyahoga Community College and Kent State University.
