This program awards maximum credit for an associate degree from Cuyahoga Community College, streamlining completion of a bachelor's degree from Malone University, fulfilling most of the core requirements, and guaranteeing junior status.

## In order to graduate, all students must complete:

- A minimum of 124 semester credits (combined Tri-C and Malone University)
- Meet Malone University's residency requirement of 30 credit hours.
- Earn an overall g.p.a. of 2.0 and a major g.p.a. of 2.5.
