

- Courses do not have to be completed in sequential order except:
 - NRSE 4510
 - NRSE 4600
- Two nursing courses incorporate virtual clinical experience NRSE 4520 and NRSE 4560
- Capstone Project for last nursing class NRSE 4600

Admission Requirements

- Be a resident in an eligible state with an active unencumbered RN license **OR** a temporary license issued in response to COVID-19 **OR** confirmation with date/location of scheduled NCLEX
- Hold an associate degree or diploma in nursing
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher from all previously attended postsecondary institutions
- ENG 1510 Writing and Rhetoric I

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

- BSN completion is possible in one year or less




Nondegree Nursing Early Start Enrollment*

- Currently enrolled in an associate degree in nursing program from an eligible institution
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher from all prior colleges or institutions attended
- Completion of Foundations of Nursing I in an associate degree program

*Courses taken as nondegree are not eligible for financial aid
