Walsh University Requirements for BA in Organizational Development and Leadership

This may allow Cuyahoga Community College students to take additional courses at Cuyahoga Community College before transferring to Walsh University. Once an associate degree has been earned, financial aid may not be applicable to additional coursework taken at Tri-C, see a campus Financial Aid Office for questions.

NOTE: All students must take their last 27 credit hours at Walsh University and at least 15 credit hours of coursework in your major.
