

Our Mission

The Student Support Services program at Cuyahoga Community College seeks to support students who have the potential to complete a college degree.

Our focus is to ensure that students have a realistic chance to persist in college and within three years to graduate with a certificate, an associate degree and /or transfer to a four-year institution to pursue a bachelor's degree.

We provide a personalized learning environment that inspires engaged learning, independent responsibility and community connection.

Eligible participants must:

- Be low income and/or first-generation college students (Parents do not have a bachelor's degree)
- Be seeking a first associate degree
- Have an academic need for support services (enrolled in math 0910, 0950, 0960, English 0980, 0990) a low ACT score or a GED, or out of school five or more years
- Be enrolled or accepted for enrollment at Cuyahoga Community College
- Be U.S. citizens, permanent residents or refugees
- Have a cumulative GPA 2.0 or higher
- Have less than 40 earned or attempted credit hours
- Be enrolled in 12 or more credit hours

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
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
