## **Call for Entries**

The North Olmsted Arts Commission invites Northeast Ohio artists who are veterans from all branches of the military (active, retired and prior service) to participate in the 2020 Veterans Art Gallery. The goal of this virtual exhibit is to provide a space for veterans to display art inspired by their combat and military service while giving the public a better understanding of the military experience.

Submissions may be visual art of any medium or performance art such as music or poetry. Art pieces are encouraged, but not required, to reflect on any aspect of military service – training and combat, fellowship, separation from family, minority perspectives or the transition back to civilian life.

The gallery will be virtual and hosted on the city's website and social media channels. The gallery will be available to the public from October 3 to November 13, 2020.

Submission Requirements:

- Complete our online form <a href="https://bit.ly/3if8CAv">https://bit.ly/3if8CAv</a> by September 11, 2020.
- For visual art, original works may be in any medium, including oils, acrylic, watercolor, pottery, wood and photography. Attach a JPEG, PDF or MP4 of the artwork with a file size no larger than 5 MB.
- For performance art, video recordings of music, poetry or narrative readings may be up to four minutes in duration. Artists may include a link to YouTube, Dropbox or other transfer system for large files.
- The artist name and title of the work is required. Artist reflection, description of military
  experience and/or description of artwork is optional but will be included in the gallery if
  provided.
- Content should be suitable for all audiences. The Arts Commission has the sole discretion to approve works for inclusion in the Veterans Art Gallery.
